A Compromise Doesn't Have to Equal a Breach

The CyberEdge [2016 Cyber Threat Defense Report](#) was just published, and it's not surprising that the threat actors are gaining ground. The research study, polling 1,000 information security professionals in enterprise organisations, reports that over 75% of those surveyed said that they were successfully attacked in 2015— a 7% increase over 2014. 62% of respondents expect that they will be successfully attacked in the coming year, which means they expect the bad guys to continue to get in. That's a 19% increase in respondents that believe their preventative technologies will be circumvented.

In light of these trends, a major shift is underway that has info security teams focusing increasingly on monitoring, detection and response rather than continuing with the traditional emphasis on prevention. In fact, Gartner projects that within four years, 60% of information security budgets will be spent on technologies that can bolster an organisations ability to detect and respond to threats.
